# MARCH ART SHOW PREVIEW

## Back to Basics

RED DOT Art Fair returns to New York City, continuing its mission to offer both new and seasoned collectors a different way to discover fine art.

In its second successful year, RED DOT Art Fair in New York City brings together more than 45 top galleries displaying works available for sale by both their emerging and established gallery artists. This vetted, hotel-based art fair will take place March 27th through 30th, 2008 on three adjacent floors of exhibition space in the elegant Park South Hotel of New York City, 122 E. 28th Street, between Park and Lexington.

Gallery owner George Billis and artist Art Greco founded the RED DOT Art Fairs and expanded it to Miami Beach in December 2007. The unique event harkens back to the roots of American art fairs with a goal of “extending visibility to quality galleries and artists who might otherwise go unnoticed because of limited discretionary budgets.”

Galleries participating in RED DOT come from across the United States and abroad, including young dealers exhibiting for the first time, as well as more established dealers who appreciate an alternative art fair venue.

Kathryn Markel Fine Arts of New York will be showing work by Peter Hoffer, a landscape artist from Montreal, Los Angeles abstract painter Alex Couwenberg, Lenore Thomas with his small wax paintings, and several others.

“We’re thrilled to be able to participate in the RED DOT Art Fair. As a hotel fair it has an intimate, informal air about it which fits in perfectly with how we see ourselves as dealers and how we see the art and the artists we work with,” says Gallery Owner Kathryn Markel.

Jenkins Johnson Gallery's core group of artists is a mix of those working in traditional disciplines, such as painting, photography, sculpture and drawing, as well as those utilizing alternative techniques like found object, digital, and video. Heather Huber, gallery manager, says RED DOT's philosophy falls right in line with theirs.

"Gallery represented artists make for a program that is a well-balanced fusion of emerging, mid-career, and established artists," says Huber. "We strive to expand our stable by embracing and promoting artists burgeoning in their fields as innovators that will engage viewers and collectors."
